INTRODUCTION

The Upper Siang District once a frontier sub-division of East Siang District was bifurcated to a full fledged district in 1994-95 with an approximate area of 6000 Sq.km. It is situated in central part of Arunachal Pradesh bordering Mac Mohan line (China) in north, East Siang District in South, West Siang District in West and Dibang Valley District in East.

Physio-graphically, the Upper Siang District is of high mountainous type with varying climate and temperature ranging from -10 °C in the North to 35 °C in low lying area. The major rivers of the district are Siang, Yamne, Siking, Sipit, Nyigong etc. As Fisheries is concern, the district is bestowed with vast natural resources in the form of rivers, streams, lakes, swamps, WRC fields etc. suitable for development of both cold and warm water fisheries.

So, the Department of Fisheries, Upper Siang district, is trying its outmost efforts to utilize these natural resources for development of both cold and warm water fisheries despite many constraints faced by the department due lack of proper infrastructure, shortage of technical manpower, and due to gap in communication.

At present, the department is having three numbers of Transit and fish seeds farm viz, Jengging, Yingkiong and Pegu Lake. As initial these farms were established and developed with a purpose to meet the demand of table fish and fish seeds in the district. The warm water fish species both exotic and indigenous type are cultured in this farms besides producing fish seeds particularly common carp seed to meet the fish seed demands of the district.

Further, to augment the table fish and fish seeds production through people and to improve the socio-economic condition of the poor and needy people of the district, self employment generation schemes are being implemented by the department on subsidy basis under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY), Fish Farmers Dev. Agency-II (FFDA), Paddy cum fish culture, Duck cum fish farming and other state planned schemes.

Besides this, fish farmers training and exhibition programs on fisheries are conducted every year under extension and training unit of department to impart training and technical method of pisciculture so as to enable them to produce more and more table fish and seeds thereby making themselves socially and economically sound and self sufficient with balancing the demand and supply of table fish and seeds in the district.

The department gives emphasis on conservation and sustainable riverine fisheries of the district for which awareness camp and river ranching programme were initiated. Apart from this Executive ban order on destructive method of fishing and during breeding season by the District Administration was issued.

A REPORT ON VARIOUS DEVELOPMENTAL ACTIVITIES DURINGI 2015-16

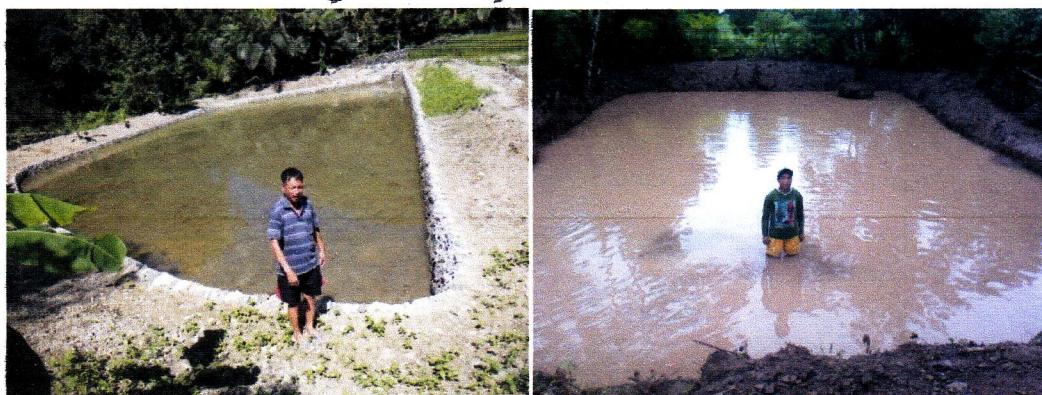

1. RASHTRIYA KRISHI VIKASH YOJANA (RKVY):-

For this scheme after received application from beneficiaries, field visit and survey of site for fish pond was done. 5. RIVER RANCHING/CONSERVATION AND AWARENESS CAMP:-

During this financial year-2015-16, Govt. has allotted Rs. 1,97,500/- for conducting riverine conservation, river ranching and two awareness camp programme. The river ranching and awareness Camp was allotted to GPTI a Vocational Training Provider(VTP) of which the awareness camp has been conducted at Yingkiong by GPTI. As report the river ranching programme shall be conducted during month of April/May.

6. Exhibition and Demonstration under ATMA:-

Under this program, fund is provided to agriculture and allied department for training and demonstration by Agriculture Technology Management Agency (ATMA) of the district. During the year 2015-16, ATMA Upper Siang district has allotted Rs. 30,000/- for conduction of demonstration campaign and exhibition. The Department of Fisheries Upper Siang district conducted demonstration Campaign in Yingkiong. Besides participation in Mass Awareness Campaign at Yingkiong, the Fisheries department has installed an Exhibition Stall during Republic Day Celebration 2016 on 26th January 2016. The fund allotted by ATMA, Yingkiong has been judiciously utilized for above mentioned programs.

Beside this, 2-Days Training & Demonstration programme on "Quality Fish Seed Production" were conducted at DFDO office Training Hall during June 2015. 20(Twenty) nos. fish farmers attended the said training and Demonstration programme. The Resource person was invited from KVK, Geku and E.O. (Fisheries) from BDO office.

7. EXPOSURE VISIT AND TRAINING PROGRAMME UNDER MLA LADS

During this financial year, the local MLA 34th Tutting-Yingkiong A/C, Sri Alo Libang, allotted Rs. 3.0 Lakhs for exposure visit and for conduct training to educated unemployed youth of above constituency under Capacity Building programme. The beneficiaries visited Kolkata during month of December to expose itself about importance of fish and fisheries of the other state. During the month of March 2016, 7-Days training programme was conducted allied with other agriculture and allied sector. All together, 78 trainees were attended in this 7 (Seven) long days training and demonstration programme.

8. MAINTENANCE OF GOVT. FISH FARM YINGKIONG (CSFS):-

The Fisheries department upper Siang district has one fish farm at yingkiong and one transit nursery at Jengging. During the financial as report, the govt. has allotted Rs. 2.5 Laksh for maintenance under CFSF. The allotted fund was utilized for farm maintenance and for procurement of fish seeds/fish feed and other farm inputs. De-siltation of rearing and stocking pond No. 01 and 04 and repairing of CC wall and earthen channel for pond No.01 was done.

9. RECLAMATION OF GOVT. BEELS AND LAKE (RBL):-

Under reclamation of beels and lake Govt. has allotted 2.5 lake for reclamation of Govt. Pegu Lake. The fund allotted was utilized for maintenance/repairing of the side wall of lake which was in deplorable condition and de-siltation at inlet side of the lake has been done. The fund allotted was also utilize for procurement of farm inputs such as fish seeds/fish feed etc.

10. REVENUE GENERATION :-

11. FREE FISH SEED DISTRIBUTION TO PROGRESSIVE FISH FARMERS

Quality of fish is the main component for taking up any best fisheries culture practice. To encourage and support to progressive fish farmers of the district, fund was allotted for free fish seed distribution to fish farmers amounting of Rs.1,165.00 lakh. One hundred fish farmers has been targeted this year and the distribution programme shall be done in ensuing season. Carried over from financial year 2014-15. in this

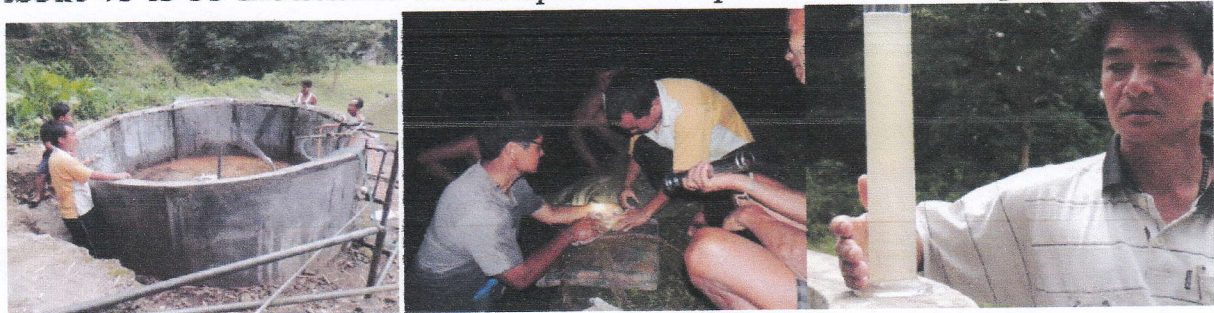
programme, free fish seed distribution to 80 nos. fish farmers was done at Govt. Fish Farm Yingkiong during this reported year.

12. HATCHERY OPERATION :-

With limited technical staff and resources, the department has tried its best to produce fish seeds at Govt. Fish Farm Yingkiong to meet up the fish seed demand of the district and revenue for the govt. The hatchery operation/hapa breeding was carried out during month of June & July. About 45 to 55 thousands of late spawn were produced in this operation.
