## Dear Mr. Negi,

First of all let me thank you for extending support in implementation of Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana under which 7.58 crore accounts have already been opened as on 18th of November, 2014. As you may be aware, these accounts come with 2 – 3 other incidental benefits such as issue of RuPay Card, coverage of accidental death insurance up to Rs.1 lakh, and coverage of life insurance of Rs.30,000 for accounts opened during the campaign period. I am enclosing herewith a note about how these benefits can be obtained by the account holders.

- 2. More important than opening new accounts is the survey of every household which indicates that so far 80% of the households have been covered with bank accounts. The position of coverage of households in your State as also District-wise coverage is enclosed for your information. I request you to issue directions to District Collectors of your State to verify the authenticity of the data of total households and help banks in achieving full coverage in their respective Districts. These details may also be seen on our website www.pmjdy.gov.in.
- Also, now that most of the households have got bank accounts, it would be useful if these accounts remain active and transactions take place in these accounts regularly. It would be useful if the State Government utilises these bank accounts for transfer of benefits under various Government schemes of the State Government so that the benefit reaches directly. Our banks would be very happy to extend all the support of the State Government if they want to transfer benefit of any scheme including MNREGA through these bank accounts.
- 4. I would be grateful if you could kindly call a meeting of all the Secretaries and explore the possibility of transfer of benefits in the bank accounts of beneficiaries for all State Government schemes.
