Emchi hosts training on fish

YUPIA | Jun 25 | A five-day capacity building training on 'Fish breeding techniques & basics of aquaculture' concluded at Emchi FFTC on Friday. In all 25 fish farmers of Changlang, Namsai, Longding, East Siang and Papum Pare districts benefited from the training.

Fisheries commissioner Huzar Lollen, addressing the valedictory function exhorted the trainees to implement knowledge earned in the field to benefit while sharing it with others.

RGU fisheries department dean Prof. D.N. Das along with a team of research scholars attended the training, aimed at training on induced breeding of fish and familiarize about the techniques.

Fish seed produced during the course of training in two successful breeding operations with active involvement of the trainees were released in the nursery pond of Emchi fish farm while 3 lakh spawn was given to Seppa DFDO for further rearing and another one lakh spawn was given as complimentary to the fish farmers of East Siang district, according to DFDP N Tania.
